MISSION APPEAL – SATURDAY/SUNDAY – JULY 14/15

The weekend of July14/15 we will welcome Sr. Mary Sean Hodges, OP, who is working with the missions in Haiti (Hands Together). In Haiti there lives about 10.0MM people. 70% of these cannot read, and 85% live below poverty level. In slum areas 4 out of 5 children do not reach the age of five, and nationally – 1 in 3 children suffer from chronic malnutrition. The hurricanes in 2004 and 2008, along with the devastating January 2010 earthquake, have left Haiti severely damaged and in desperate need of our support. Hands Together runs free schools, medical clinic and nutrition programs in Cite Soleil, providing 25 thousand daily school meals and helping thousands of people who struggle to survive.
