## SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY ARE UNIVERSAL DAYS OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE. Anyone over the age of 18 and under the age of 59 are obliged to fast and abstain.

Fasting, is the limitation of food and drink – typically to one main meal and two smaller meals, with no solid foods in between. Abstaining, in this context, is the refraining from certain kinds of food or drink. typically meat.

### NINEVEH FAST

Chaldean Catholics in Irag are undertaking a three-day "Nineveh fast". Cardinal Louis Raphaël Sako, head of the Chaldean Catholic Church, issued a statement calling on Catholics to fast and pray on Ash Wednesday, February 17th, Thursday, February 18th and Friday, February 19th. The three-day fast recalls the three days that Jonah spent inside of the whale and the repentance of the Ninevites.

"Let us repent of our sins, pray for salvation from the COVID-19 pandemic, contemplate the meaning of our existence, assume our responsibilities towards our brothers and sisters and our communities, and express solidarity ... with people who have lost their jobs and livelihood, and extend a helping hand to them"

### ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

Due to changes in the program during the first days of Lent, there will be no adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from Wednesday to Friday (February 17-19).

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed next week only on Monday and Tuesday, February 15 and 16 from 18: 00-20: 00.

IN TODAY'S SECOND READING St. Paul says that "whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God." We can glorify God through our work by realizing that our daily tasks can be the sacrifices we offer up to God. Therefore, let us strive to intentionally say a prayer every morning asking God to help us glorify Him throughout our day
