“**STAY AT HOME ORDER**” **does not** change current restrictions for places of worship. It means that we will continue with our daily tasks based on the following guidelines:

- Attendance is limited to 15% capacity of the worship space (including those assisting – priest, cantor, etc.) for sacramental celebrations, with the exception of funerals (see below). Physical distancing must be observed at all times.
- Funerals are limited to 50 people (including those assisting but not including funeral home staff)
- Parish halls should not be used for overflow or multiple celebrations at this time.

- We are limiting one-time reservation to 4 tickets (to allow more families chance of registration);
- We are reserving up to 4 tickets for the family who booked a Mass; Please, give us a call, so we can update our list with your name;
- All Saturday/Sunday Masses are posted under the same event. Once you choose the event and click register, you will be able to pick the time of Mass;
- Please do not send your request for Mass tickets via email, or leave voice messages;
- We are here at the office to help, however in recent weeks, we are experiencing extremely high volumes of calls and emails. Be prepared to wait.

**IMPORTANT REMINDERS:**

- **Church operates at 15% capacity** with social distancing measures in place. Registration needed for all next week Masses;
- **Please stay home if you are not feeling well, you have been in contact with a Covid-19 positive individual or you have a compromised immune system.**
- **Use only main entrance.** Upon entry use disinfectant and go to available seat and Practice Physical Distancing.
- **No signing during Mass;**
- **Sunday Offering and any other “Special Collections Envelopes” will be received at the doors of the church**
- **As a Sign of Peace, bow your head towards your neighbour;**
- **Holy Communion is distributed only in the hand at this time.**
