Once filled, form can be thrown into the offering basket or forwarded to the office. Please inform us of any address changes.

PARISH ENVELOPES

Parishioners who wish to help the Parish financially can do so using offering envelopes. Regular users receive them once a year, usually in the month of December. New ones are asked to contact the Parish Office, fill the registration form, and check the "offering envelopes" box.

Contributions for the church are tax-deductible. Income tax return forms are distributed to Parishioners at the end of January.

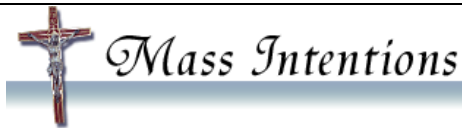

SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY - August 15. There will be blessing of flowers and herbs during all Masses on Saturday (Vigil) and Sunday, August 14/15.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is one of the most joyful of our liturgical Solemnities. On this day we recall Our Lady's being assumed into Heaven and crowned Queen

On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of Mary to be a dogma of faith: "We pronounce, declare and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma that the immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory."

NOVENA TO ST. MONIKA

This year, the liturgical memorial of St. Monika, on August 27, will be preceded by a nine-day novena. From August 19, we will be celebrating Holy Masses for children who have abandoned their faith. Cards with their names can be thrown into the box placed on the table next to the baptismal font.

AUGUST 2ND IS THE FEAST OF PORTIUNCULA. A plenary indulgence is available to anyone who will: receive sacramental confession (8 days before or after), receive the Holy Eucharist at Holy Mass on August 2nd, enter a parish church and pray the Our Father, Apostles Creed, and a pray of his/her own choosing for the intentions of the pope.

The Portiuncula indulgence is the first plenary indulgence that was ever granted in the Church. It was offered by Our Merciful Lord Himself, in honor of His Immaculate Mother and the chapel dedicated to her, and made possible at the request of St Francis.
