HUMANITARIAN HELP - HAITI

The Archdiocese of Toronto has opened a humanitarian relief fund to assist Haiti, which recently has been stricken by a 7.2 magnitude earthquake and a tropical storm. At least 1,900 people are dead, 9,000 are injured and 30,000.

Haiti it is the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere and is unable to adequately respond to these natural disasters without international assistance. The country was already responding to the COVID-19 pandemic, worsening gang violence and a presidential assassination on July 7, 2021. The Archdiocese of Toronto will send donations through Caritas and will be used for food, water, shelter, clothing and medical supplies.
