Once filled, form can be thrown into the offering basket or forwarded to the office. Please inform us of any address changes.

## **PARISH ENVELOPES**

Parishioners who wish to help the Parish financially can do so using offering envelopes. Regular users receive them once a year, usually in the month of December. New ones are asked to contact the Parish Office, fill the registration form, and check the "offering envelopes" box.

Contributions for the church are tax-deductible. Income tax return forms are distributed to Parishioners at the end of January.

**BEATIFICATION OF POLISH CARDINAL STEFAN WYSZYNSKI AND MOTHER ROZA CZACKA**  
Cardinal Wyszyński, the Primate of Poland who led the Church’s resistance to communism, and Mother Czacka, who pioneered a new kind of ministry for blind people, will be beatified in the Polish capital, Warsaw, on Sept. 12.  
In the letter to be read out in churches, Poland’s bishops noted that both Czacka and Wyszyński were deeply devoted to the Virgin Mary. “Each of them entrusted their way to holiness to the Blessed Mother and wanted to serve God and man as Mary did. Mother Elżbieta made her act of consecration to the Mother of God on Dec. 8, 1921, saying: ‘I choose you today as my Mother, Protector...’ And the Primate, imprisoned in Stoczek Warmiński, on Dec. 8, 1953, said: ‘I consecrate my body and my soul to you (...) everything that I am and everything that I possess.’”
